## SCHEDULED ROAD WORK

Dear Resident,

Work is expected to begin the week of August 13 on the above named roads. The contractor working on the roads will be WJC Company. The Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District #2 (District) will be coordinating work with the Contractor and the County.

The above roads have been surveyed in the past, but you may notice additional right of way (ROW) markings so as to provide guidance for the work. Trees in the ROW will be removed where the work will be performed to construct the road and/or install drainage ditches. Work will only be performed within the ROW. In many cases, the ROW is located substantially closer to the home than many property owners realize.

The first phase of work will be to "cut" the concrete driveways at those locations where the culvert pipe needs to be replaced. Culverts will be installed/replaced and bar ditches will be installed and/or improved.

Once all of the underground work has been completed, road base will be brought in to provide a proper road bed and a proper crown. The construction phase of the work should be completed in about two months.

The chip seal process will depend on the County's schedule and weather.

Temporary mailboxes will be relocated to a central location during construction. If you have a mailbox made of stone the District will remove the mailbox and place it on your property. Damage may occur during removal. The District is not responsible for damaged mailboxes. Mailboxes can be replaced by owner after the chip seal process is completed.

Try to avoid the work area as much as possible while construction is occurring. The less traffic, the more efficiently the work can be completed.
