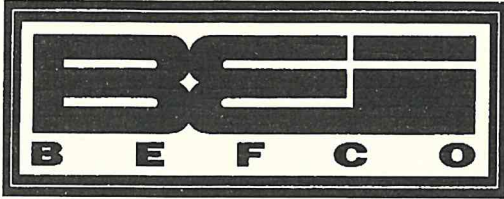

Dear Mr. Hightower:

The bid opening for the Bastrop County WCID No. 2 Compliance Water Line Improvements project was held on Friday, November 18, 2022. The bid documents were provided to approximately twelve (12) contractors as well as six (6) plan rooms. BCWCID#2 also advertised the project in the LOCALiQ and The Eagle newspapers to run from 10/31/2022 through 11/25/2022. The District received five (5) bids for the project ranging from \$712,936.29 to \$1,188,022.00 for the total base bid (Items 1-75).

The base bid was for the construction of a 6-inch water line along Kaupo Drive and associated meter connections/service bores, an 8-inch water line along El Camino Road and associated meter connections/service bores, a 6-inch water line along Hawea Lane and associated meter connections/service bores and service bores/meter connections along Keanahalululu Lane. Additive alternate bid items to bore Kaupo Drive and Keanahalululu Lane water line crossings in lieu of open cut method were also included (AA1 and AA2). These additive alternates would add \$18,609.30 and \$19,650 to the respective two lowest base bids. Based on discussions with District personnel, we recommend it best to proceed with the two Alternate Bid Items to minimize traffic disruptions that would be caused by an open cut installation in the base bid. Please see the attached Bid Tab Summary for the base bid and additive alternates from the various bidders.

The two lowest bidders on this project were WJC Constructors, LLC and Qro Mex Construction Company, Inc. WJC Constructors, LLC was the lowest bidder with a base bid of \$712,936.29 and total base bid plus alternates AA1 and AA2 of \$731,545.59. After careful review of the bid documents, it was determined that WJC Constructors, LLC did not meet the minimum project reference requirement to provide at least three (3) references for successful experience constructing water line projects with a minimum \$300,000 project cost. WJC only listed one (1) reference meeting this requirement (City of Smithville Loop 230 Water Line project). BEFCO does know that WJC Constructors, LLC has successfully completed construction on an additional water line project for the City of La Grange as it was designed by BEFCO Engineering, Inc. and was in excess of \$300,000 construction cost. This project was not identified in WJC's bid submission. Per the bid contract book and specifications: "The Owner reserves the right to waive formalities, to reject any and all bids, to accept bids based on alternate items and quantities specified, and to accept the bid most advantageous to the Owner and that will result in the best and most economical completion of the project." **Should the**

District choose to award the project to WJC in the amount of \$731,545.59, BCWCID #2 Board would need to waive the reference requirement in the bid package.

The next lowest bid was submitted by Qro Mex Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$724,931.00 and total base bid plus alternates AA1 and AA2 of \$744,581.00. Qro Mex provided a complete bid submittal and has significant water line construction experience, which can be observed on their extensive project reference resume they provided. Within the last year, Qro Mex successfully completed construction of the District's Tahitian Drive Water Line Project. **Should BCWCID #2 Board choose not to waive the reference requirement, BEFCO would recommend awarding the project to Qro Mex Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$744,581.00.**

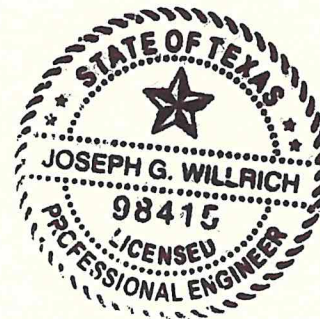

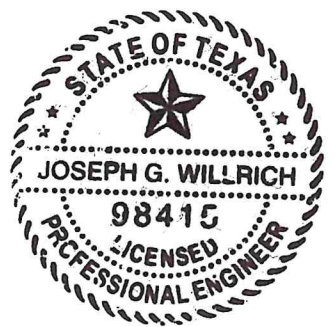

5. Liquidated Damages for Failure to Enter into Contract

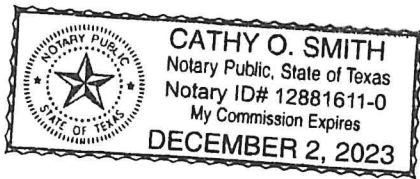

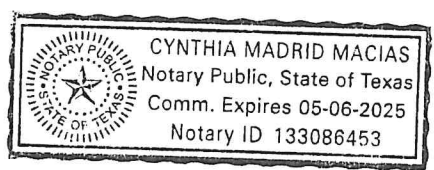
