BASTROP COUNTY WATER DISTRICT WATER / WASTEWATER EXPANSION PROCESS TO EXTEND SERVICES

- 1. Contact District to determine where existing utilities are located.
- 2. Obtain copy of the District rules and regulations for extending water and sewer service.
- 3. Provide drawings completed by surveyor to show property lines, other utilities and roadway dimensions for entire length of area in question.
- 4. Sit down with District personnel to discuss the needed size of the pipes to be extended.
- 5. Place proposed water and sewer utilities on drawings and bring to District office for review.
- 6. Once drawings are approved to proceed, have contractor (must be approved by District) gather for a preconstruction meeting.
- 7. Provide the District with a list of materials that will be purchased from the parts distributor for review by the District (all materials must conform to District Specifications.
- 8. When materials are delivered to the site, a shipping list must be provided to the District for approval before work commences.
- 9. Only the District personnel are to operate valves.
- 10. The District will inspect the work as it proceeds and will reject any work that is not performed pursuant to the District rules and regulations.
- 11. Water main extensions will be pressure tested and disinfected pursuant to AWWA and District Standards.
- 12.All costs of extending service will be the responsibility of the land developer/builder.
- 13. The District will accept the mains (water and/or sewer) for service once all testing and test results are acceptable.
